Pharmacy students as part of their academic curriculum under the subject *Hospital and Clinical Pharmacy*. In addition to the operational aspects, the students were introduced to the clinical roles of hospital pharmacists, such as reviewing medication therapy, offering drug-related advice to patients, monitoring treatment outcomes, and collaborating with doctors and nurses to optimize patient care. The students also learned how pharmacy staff manage medication inventory efficiently to ensure continuous availability of essential drugs while minimizing wastage.

The interaction with the pharmacy staff was particularly insightful, as students learned about the day-to-day challenges faced in hospital pharmacy practice. Topics such as managing medication shortages, handling high workloads, and ensuring patient adherence to prescribed

treatments were discussed. The pharmacy professionals shared valuable experiences and emphasized the importance of communication and patient education in clinical settings.

This field visit proved to be a highly enriching experience, helping students appreciate the crucial role hospital pharmacists play in improving patient outcomes. It also highlighted areas for potential improvement, including enhancing patient education efforts, refining inventory control practices, and expanding clinical pharmacy services within hospital settings.
